

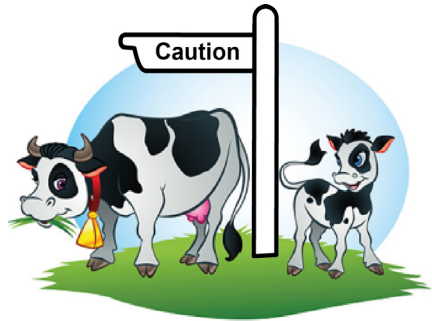

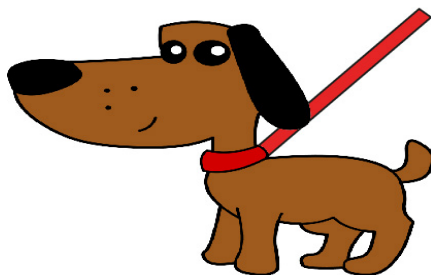

## **GRADING OF WALKS**

Most of the Derbyshire Dales walks fall into one of the following four grades. These have been modified to bring them more in line with national grades.

### **XL – Extra Leisurely**

Walks over uneven ground requiring sturdy footwear. Distances will generally not exceed 4 miles or 7 kms and will be taken at a gentle pace.

### **L – Leisurely**

Walks for people with at least a little country walking experience. May include unsurfaced rural paths. Walking boots and warm, waterproof clothing are recommended.

### **M – Moderate**

Walks for people with country walking experience and a reasonable level of fitness. May include some steep paths and open country and may be at a brisk pace. Walking boots and warm, waterproof clothing are essential.

### **S – Strenuous**

Walks for experienced country walkers with an above average level of fitness. May include hills and rough country and may be at a brisk pace. Walking boots and warm, waterproof clothing are essential.

**Additional advice** - Walk gradings are provided as a general guide only. If you have any doubts contact the leader in advance.

Bear in mind the distance of the walk and the possibility of bad weather which can make a walk more difficult than planned.

Leaders may refuse to accept participants who in their opinion are inadequately equipped or unfit.
